

IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT REFLECTIONS

1. We had a very large number of students auditioning. **If you did not make the group, that DOES NOT mean you are not a great singer.** The group must be balanced, considering the number of voice parts needed. Everyone is a valuable part of One Voice Choir and it is a great experience just to go through the audition process.
2. If you are in Reflections you are committing to our Reflections schedule. You are also committing to a possible tour or mini-tour during Spring Break.
3. If you are in Reflections you are committing to attendance each week at 4:00, choir at 5:00, and worship at 6:15 on Sundays. Consistently being late is considered absent and with so many auditioning, you may not be in the group if you are consistently absent or late. *Remember the commitment form you have signed which includes commitment to:*
 - Our weekly rehearsal time on Sunday afternoons at 4:00 p.m.
 - Singing both in our church and away from FBC as scheduled.
 - Being a committed and active leader in One Voice Choir. (Displaying conduct that is a good example for others to follow and doesn't distract from our rehearsal. Talking, texting, not participating, etc is not appropriate for leaders who are in Reflections. Consistently late is like being absent!)
 - Being an active part of Sunday School and Student Ministry activities.
 - Living a life that is a Christian example to others. This includes your actions away from church, at school, on Facebook and other social media, and everywhere.
 - Having a positive attitude and promoting unity in our youth group.
 - Going on One Voice Choir Tour June 10-19, 2016. (You must leave and return with the group.)
