TAKING THE HELMET OF SALVATION MEANS:

① You are **Rescued**

“He has sent Me to proclaim release to the captives.” Luke 4:18

“It is by the name of Jesus...salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.” Acts 4:10, 12

“When he came to his senses...he got up and came to his father...and his father felt love for him, and ran and embraced him and kissed him.” Luke 15:17, 20

② You are **Reprogramming**

*“The weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of strongholds...we are taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ.”
2 Corinthians 10:4-5*

③ You are **Ready**

“As you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, having been firmly rooted and built up in Him....See to it that no one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deception, according to the tradition of men.” Colossians 2:6-8

④ You are **Reassured**

“I give eternal life to them, and they shall never perish; and none shall snatch them out of My hand. My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father’s hand.” John 10:28-29
