 *Luke 8:22-25 (page 732 in the pew Bible)*

## ① The **Fact** Calls Forth: Storms come even when **Jesus** is with you.

*"I have told you these things, so that in Me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world." John 16:33*

## ② **Fear** Cries Out: When you focus on the **storm**.

*"The disciples went and woke Him, saying, 'Lord save us! We're going to drown!'" Matthew 8:25*

## ③ **Faith** Calms Down: When you focus on the **Savior**.

*"I will lift up my eyes to the hills — where does my help come from? My help comes from the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth." Psalm 121:1-2*

### Application:

- A. **Evacuate**: You may not need to ride out the storm.
- B. Move to **higher ground**: Don't jump in a ditch.
- C. Have an **emergency plan**: Avoid dirt and debris.
- D. Rest in the **loving arms** of Jesus:

The levees of His love and protection never fail.
