We must have a BIG view of **God** and a SMALL view of **man**.

Sovereign: having a supreme rank, power, or authority. Supreme; preeminent;
indisputable: being above all others in character, importance, excellence

How is God **Sovereign**?

 **Isaiah 46:5-11** (page 518 in the pew Bible)

① He is **Supremely Preeminent** (vs. 9-10)

② He has a **purpose** (v. 10)

What is His purpose? His Glory

“I will say to the north, ‘Give them up!’ and to the south, ‘Do not hold them back.’
Bring my sons from afar and my daughters from the ends of the earth— everyone who
is called by my name, whom I created for my glory, whom I formed and made.” Lead
out those who have eyes but are blind, who have ears but are deaf.” Isaiah 43:6-8

“So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.”

③ He **can accomplish His purpose.** (v.11)

④ He **will accomplish His purpose.** (v.11)
