## ① DAVID COMMITS SIN

*“But each one is tempted when, by his own evil desire, he is dragged away and enticed. Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death.” James 1:14-15*

## ② DAVID CONCEALS SIN

*“He who conceals his sins does not prosper, but whoever confesses and renounces them finds mercy.” Proverbs 28:13*

## ③ DAVID’S CONVICTION OF SIN

*“But I tell you the truth: It is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him to you. When He comes, He will convict the world of guilt in regard to sin and righteousness and judgment”  
John 16:7-8*

## ④ DAVID’S CONFESSION OF SIN

*“If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.” 1 John 1:9*

## ⑤ DAVID’S CLEANSING FROM SIN

*“Have mercy on me, O God, according to Your unfailing love; according to Your great compassion blot out my transgressions. Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin.” Psalm 52:1-2*
