Learn & Live God’s Prayer Principles:

① Prayer’s **Objective** (vs.3-6)

“His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and His eyes were like blazing fire. His feet were like bronze glowing in a furnace, and His voice was like the sound of rushing waters.” Revelation 1:14-13

② Prayer’s **Opposition** (v.13)

“The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.” John 10:10

③ Prayer’s **Operation**

1. Begin with a **Burden** (v.2)

“Brothers and sisters, my heart’s desire and prayer to God for the Israelites is that they may be saved.” Romans 10:1

2. Continue with **Perseverance** (vs.2-3)

“So I say to you: Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.” Luke 11:9

3. Master your **Weapons** (v.12)

“Pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying.” Ephesians 6:18
