Joshua's Four Principles to Pass On:

① **Look past yourself** (v.3)

“Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.” Philippians 2:4

② **Remember What God has done for you** (v.3)

“Consider what great things He has done for you.” 1 Samuel 12:24

③ **Examine Your Foundation** (v.6)

“And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house, but it did not fall, because it had been founded on the rock.” Matthew 7:25

④ **Filter Who or What Influences You** (v.7)

“Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers” Psalm 1:1
