Facilities facilitate ministries! So it is time for us to create some new and improved facilities that will enable us to be more effective servants of King Jesus.

In 2017-2018, we created and adopted a facilities analysis plan. We dove deep into an examination of the 372,000 square feet of buildings that comprise our campus. Our team of 17 friends plus the church staff prayerfully asked the question: What is the best use of our facilities that will produce the maximum Kingdom Impact? These prayerful and careful considerations yielded four objectives.

- 1) Remodel adult classrooms on the 5th and 6th floors of the main building to give us a capacity for 420 people to facilitate disciple-making.
- 2) Grow our International Ministry by reconfiguring the Miller building to facilitate this vital ministry.
- 3) Transform the media center by the sanctuary to an open welcome center to facilitate fellowship.
- 4) Create a new Caring Center. Our Community Ministries is the heart of FBC. We meet a vast array of needs for God's children. This Ministry impacts tens of thousands of lives. Twenty years ago, we acquired the old First Presbyterian facility and we've used it effectively. However, the buildings are deteriorating, and they are a maintenance "money pit." After three years of study, we determined our best option is to build a new facility that will enable Community Ministries to expand and effectively touch even more people in the future with the love and light of Jesus Christ.

After much prayerful and careful study, the plans have been created and it's time to invite our wonderful church family to provide the funding for these projects that will facilitate God's work at FBC for decades to come. Seek God's guidance regarding how you can financially support this exciting opportunity to serve King Jesus by ministering more effectively to more of His children.

It boils down to this truth: Will you give your minimum or MAXIMUM? Jesus gave His best and most for us, so we are compelled to give our best and most for Him.

Join me in using your earthly resources to make an eternal difference as we BUILD**TOGETHER!**

OUR JOURNEY TOGETHER

WHAT WE HAVE DONE

Four years ago, our church began an assessment of our facilities and future ministries. A Facility Analysis Team was approved and this team began to pray, meet, study, and plan for our future needs. After proper time and communication with our congregation, their recommendations were presented and **unanimously approved on May 20, 2018.**

This plan included:

Property Acquisition

- Mendelsohn Building Purchase approved by FBC. Task accomplished.
- The Rudder Parking Lot should remain a top priority for FBC because of its proximity to current FBC properties.

Education Space

- Renovate 5th and 6th floor of Main Building
- Relocate Single Adults from 6th Floor Main to Current Senior Adult Center.

Huff Community Ministries Building

- Raze entire Huff Community Ministries Building
- Preserve historical elements of building where possible
- Construct a functional Caring Center facility and FBC storage facility with a much smaller footprint (15,000-25,000 square feet) than current Huff Building

Miscellaneous

- Renovate Miller Building
- Relocate FBC Media Center
- Renovate current Media Center space to become welcome center, coffee shop, prayer room
- Encourage enhanced use of FBC Kitchen

Othe

 Appoint committees through the Church Leadership Council as needed to accomplish tasks

WHAT WE ARE DOING

Now we are moving into the implementation of the plan we approved May of 2018. Our BUILD**TOGETHER** emphasis will assist our church in meeting her funding needs for our upcoming building projects and provide for a vibrant ministry into the future. It is our goal to ensure that God's Word will be studied and proclaimed to future generations and to all nations. We desire to be certain that our facilities are viewed as tools to properly facilitate our ministries. And we wish to provide an inviting and welcoming atmosphere to enable us to continue to reach new people.



SCOPE OF THE PROJECT

Our BUILD**TOGETHER** emphasis includes four major areas of construction, renovation, and enhancement for our ministries.

These areas include:

- The renovation of both the 5th and 6th floors of our main building education space. This area will be reconfigured to meet our needs for future adult space.
- The renovation of the first floor of the Miller Building (office building near fellowship hall entrance). This area will be repurposed to house our growing international ministries and enable us to continue to reach all nations with the gospel.
- The renovation of the existing media center (in main sanctuary) and transforming this space into a welcome center and gathering area. This will enhance fellowship, communication, and hallway traffic flow during busy times.
- To replace the existing Huff Building with a small and more functional building for our Community Ministries usage. While the destruction of the old First Presbyterian facility is not a pleasant thought, it is necessary. The sanctuary bell tower and historical façade may be saved and incorporated into a new, safe, and more sustainable facility that we can use for generations to come.



OUR PRIVILEGE
