On Sunday, May 2, we will be recognizing our seniors during the 11:00 AM worship service. The following are some important details for that day.

Sunday, May 2, 2021

- 9:45 AM** Graduates meet in the Youth Center for a time of prayer, encouragement and photos. (Parents welcome to join)
- 10:30 AM** Graduates go to the Main Sanctuary to practice the processional.
- 11:00 AM** **Recognition Service** (Parents and family members will be seated behind the graduates. Recommended attire: **coat & tie for guys** and **white dress for girls**) Most girls wear heirloom dresses that they use for other graduation events, however this is not required. But if you would like help finding a white heirloom dress to borrow, just let me know.
- 12:00 PM** **Luncheon in the Fellowship Hall** for graduates and family members (Try & limit guests to immediate family, but if you have other family/friends that would like to attend, we will allow). The lunch will be free for the graduates but each additional guest will be \$10 and this can be paid for by following the instructions below.

Slide Show: Each year the Student Ministry creates a lasting memory of this special day...a video slideshow of the class showing their growth from baby to senior. For the slide show, please submit the following pictures digitally in high quality (.jpeg or .png at least 100kb each) at the online registration page: **1 baby picture, 1 elementary school picture, 1 junior high picture, and 1 senior portrait.** For the 4th picture (senior portrait), we would prefer to have a digital copy from the photographer. If you don't have this, the photographer can email it to jspivey@montgomeryfbc.org. Please crop the photos prior to submitting (if necessary) and name them in the following manner – lastnamefirstinitial#. For instance I would submit my photos like this:

mccroryr1 for the baby picture
mccroryr2 for the elementary picture
mccroryr3 for the junior high picture
mccroryr4 for the senior portrait.
