A Word about Funding

At FBC Montgomery, we have been blessed to provide additional funding to help offset the costs to participants. The costs listed in this menu include housing, flights, transportation, and most meals. In addition, the FBC Montgomery budget will help subsidize the costs of translators, supplies, and other expenses involved in successfully completing mission trips. On average, mission projects are subsidized by 70% of the cost of the trip!

The FBC Montgomery Budget and funds from budget overage have subsidized all trips. Additional scholarships are available upon request. We don't want money to be the thing that keeps anyone from going.

This church uses its church facility as a temporary refuge for Ukrainians until they obtain proper travel documents or find work inside Romania. This site is staffed by church volunteers who provide food, water, and clothing to the refugees. Our team will largely take over the operations for a week to relieve the volunteers. In addition to managing the camp (checking in new refugees, preparing and serving three meals a day, cleaning, etc.), we will conduct VBS for the children.
