

At the end of the year, the Wall Street Journal published an encouraging article stating that Bible sales are booming in the United Statesup 22% in 2024.

At a time when Pew Research Center finds that 28% of adults in the US consider themselves religiously unaffiliated, Bible sales are rising swiftly alongside books related to religion, guidance, and context for Bible engagement.

Publishers attribute this rise to several things, including a more anxious and fretful generation grappling with answers to life's most pressing auestions and solid marketing efforts to engage people with the Bible.

In the Wall Street Journal article, an individual being interviewed said, "[I] started to read the Bible this year after feeling unfilled by years of advice on self-care, staying healthy, and pursuing a career. She said she also sought stability as 'things just went off the rails a little too quickly' throughout society."

This is playing out all over the place and all around us. Folks are finding that the 'freedom' that culture has offered has continued to fall flat and leave empty.
