## **Registration/Check-In Instructions**

## **CELL PHONE POLICY**

**>This year we are once again upholding a NO CELL PHONE Policy for Students at Youth Camp.**

-This includes APPLE WATCHES with Internet/Wifi as well as iPads and other internet connected devices.

>This was the highlight for MANY of the students last year. They all bought in and we want that same atmosphere again.

>Leaders & Camp Staff will have phones with them at all times for both Emergency Contacts as well as taking photos.

>We will have a camp photographer taking & posting pictures along with our Adult Leaders doing the same.

>We will provide wake up calls in the mornings and encourage students to bring watches (&alarm clocks if necessary).

>If you feel your child needs an exception (medical or family needs, laptop for College Course), reach out to Russell.

>We will post regularly on the FBMSM Facebook/Insta & also allow students to call home any time on leader phones.

## **OPTIONAL (But Encouraged) DRESS UP NIGHT**

## **STAY CONNECTED**

We will have a DAILY PHOTO LINK at [FBMSM.COM](https://fbmsm.com) where photos will be shared each day along with the recap videos. Multiple leaders will be taking photos at camp so that students can be sure to have those memories to Save/Post/Share/Etc when they return home.

## **DRESS CODE:**

***Overall, we represent Jesus & our church. The last thing we want to do is misrepresent who we are as Christ followers. So if it is questionable, just say no.***

This year we will likely have another group from the Shocco Kids Camp staying in our two dorms (possibly of opposite gender), so students **MUST** be fully dressed outside of their rooms.

**Guys:** Must keep their shirts on at all times outside of the room, except at swimming activities.

No clothing with profanity

No clothing with references to alcohol/tobacco or logos that mimic those brands.

Guy Counselors will discreetly ask our guys to change if in violation of these things.

**Girls:** It would be helpful for parents to look thru clothing being packed to help make sure of the following.

**> Avoid Overly Short Skirts & Shorts**

-Such as Gold Hinge Pleated Skirts, Other Skirts/Shorts that have no length & reveal too much

-Cutoff Denim Shorts that are too short

-Other churches' dress policies list an actual length, but for now I'll just go with what's above.

**> Avoid Tank Tops that...**

-Show Mid-drift

-Have Spaghetti Straps

-Have Cutouts (side, front, back)

-Don't cover the chest properly.

-Are Too Tight

-Don't Have Two Straps

**> One-Piece Swimsuits Only, or dark T shirt over anything else.**

**> Shorts/skirts should be visible - even with oversized shirts.**

**\*\*\*Our female counselors will discreetly ask girls to change whose clothing isn't appropriate for camp.**

## **RULES TO DISCUSS WITH YOUR CAMPER:**

**-No Cell Phones/Devices for Students.** These should be left at home. Every leader will have a phone and we will provide parents with those numbers. This could be one of the greatest blessings you give your student....the opportunity to disconnect from social media, drama, distractions, the world, music and movies.

**-No Girls in Guys Rooms/Dorms and vice versa.**

**-Be On Time** (Be where you need to be when you need to be)

**-Go to bed when it's time to go to bed.**

**-NO PRANKS WHATSOEVER. Respect Others.**

**-No leaving rooms after lights out. This is grounds for going home.**

-No profanity. No fighting. No alcohol, tobacco, knives, or firearms. **Violators WILL be sent home.**

-On any transport vehicle, students must be seated for safety. Students cannot drive any of the counselor golf carts.

-Students/Families will be responsible for anything they break.

## **PARENTS OF YOUTH BOYS, TALK WITH THEM ABOUT THE FOLLOWING:**

>Guys need to stay out of rooms they aren't invited into.

>If there is any kind of "room raiding", "room raging", etc - where guys enter into another room and make a mess, break anything, or enter in large numbers - those involved **WON'T COME BACK TO CAMP** or DNOW. .

>Guys are not to do any kind of pranks on other rooms.

>Guys need to keep their language pure - even when leaders aren't around.

-This includes profanity, but also includes "guy talk", inappropriate jokes, etc.

>Guys need to avoid making intentional messes.

-It often looks like guys intentionally open food and just throw it everywhere.

## **PARENTS OF SENIORS, TALK WITH THEM ABOUT THE FOLLOWING**

We will have a special Senior Time late Thursday night, but after that **Seniors MUST go back to their separate dorms and to their rooms when I tell them to.** They aren't allowed to go anywhere else or start any other Senior "Traditions".

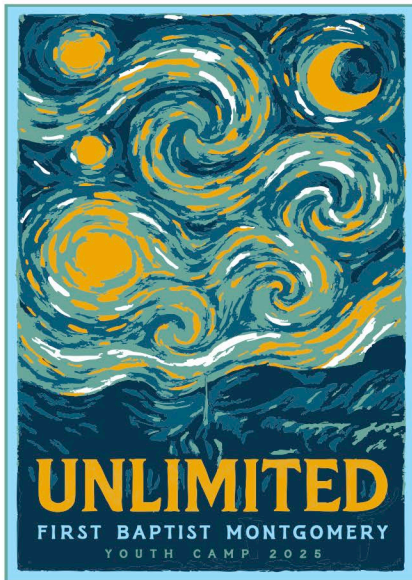

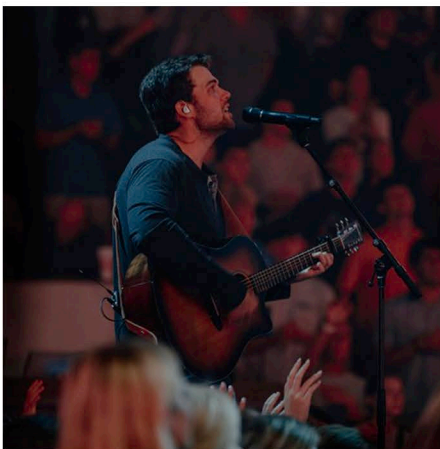
## **CAMP THEME: “UNLIMITED”**
