## **KEEP WISE IN THE** SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES

Pastor Matt Smethurst said, "Spiritual Disciplines are not about making you more precious to God. They're about making God more precious to you."



What are the Spiritual Disciplines? These are practices that help believers pursue holiness and grow in godliness. They are simple yet profound exercises that strengthen our spiritual muscles and open our ears and hearts to let the Lord work in and through us.

Donald Whitney's classic book, Spiritual Disciplines for the Christian Life, is a straightforward and transformative resource that clarifies the role of disciplines in a believer's life. He outlines Bible intake, prayer, worship, evangelism, serving, stewardship, fasting, silence and solitude, journaling, and learning as disciplines aimed at fostering spiritual growth.

Paul wrote to Timothy, Have nothing to do with irreverent, silly myths. Rather train yourself for godliness; for while bodily training is of some value, godliness is of value in every way, as it holds promise for the present life and also for the life to come. (1 Timothy 4:7-8)

Be diligent in training yourself toward godliness. Be committed to practicing the disciplines and let go of those things that do not have eternal value.


