THANKSGIVING IS COMING, DON'T MISS IT!

Little Debbie Christmas Tree Cakes have appeared on store shelves—and it's still October. You've probably walked into several stores that skipped over Thanksgiving décor and jumped straight into Christmas trees, ornaments, and gift ideas. If we're not careful, we'll miss one of the best seasons to reset our hearts into gratitude.

In the few weeks leading up to November 27, here are some practical tips to prepare your heart for this thankful season.



- 1. Memorize the Word. Our Scripture memory for November is both our Stewardship theme verse and an aid in gratefulness. And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him (Colossians 3:17).
- 2. Write down thankful things. Get a big piece of paper or sticky notes and daily add notes of what we're grateful for. For families, this can be especially helpful to involve children. Let each day be a new opportunity to be thankful for something else. Let the month be a tapestry of thanksgiving for the big and little things God has blessed us with!
- **3. Be thankful aloud.** Psalm 26:7 urges us to proclaim our thanks openly and share all of God's wondrous deeds. Verbally express your gratitude, both to the Lord and to others. Don't just think it speak it!
- 4. Slow down. This is a busy season with so much to do and prepare for. As much as you can, be still and know that He is God. Slow your soul and your pace to take time to reflect on God's grace and blessings over you. If we're not careful and intentional, Thanksgiving will pass us by on our way to a new year. Don't let it happen in your heart or your home.

Believers are thankful people. God saved us from our sins and from eternal separation from Himself. While circumstances in life can change dramatically, God's saving grace remains constant.

Encourage one another with gratitude! It's the antidote to many of our fleshly failings.
