A WORD ABOUT FUNDING

At First Baptist Montgomery, we are fortunate to provide additional funding to help reduce costs for participants. The costs listed in this menu cover housing, flights, transportation, and most meals. Additionally, the First Baptist Montgomery budget helps subsidize expenses for translators, supplies, and other necessities for successful mission trips. On average, mission projects are subsidized by 70% of the total trip cost!

All trips are supported by the First Baptist Montgomery budget and funds generated from budget overages. Furthermore, scholarships are available upon request. We believe that cost should not be a barrier for anyone wanting to participate.
