Genesis – “In the Beginning...”

Introduction

The word “*Genesis*” comes from the Greek word for “*origin*.” A broad outline of the book divides it into two halves: The first begins with the creation story and concludes with the story of Noah (*Genesis 1:1 – 11:26*); the second traces the history of Abraham to Joseph and his family in Egypt (*Genesis 11:27 – 50:26*).
