Genesis - "In the Beginning..."

Introduction

The word "Genesis" comes from the Greek word for "origin." A broad outline of the book divides it into two halves: The first begins with the creation story and concludes with the story of Noah (Genesis 1:1 - 11:26); the second traces the history of Abraham to Joseph and his family in Egypt (Genesis 11:27 - 50:26).
