Psalms – “The Bible’s Hymn Book”

Introduction

Psalms literally means “_____.”

This book consists of 150 “poems” (Hebrew parallelism of thought). It is quoted in the New Testament more than any other Old Testament book, except Isaiah.

Seventy-three of the chapters attribute _____ as their author.

Psalms is organized into five books:

1. Chapters 1 through 41
2. Chapters 42 through 72
3. Chapters 73 through 89
4. Chapters 90 through 106
5. Chapters 107 through 150
